

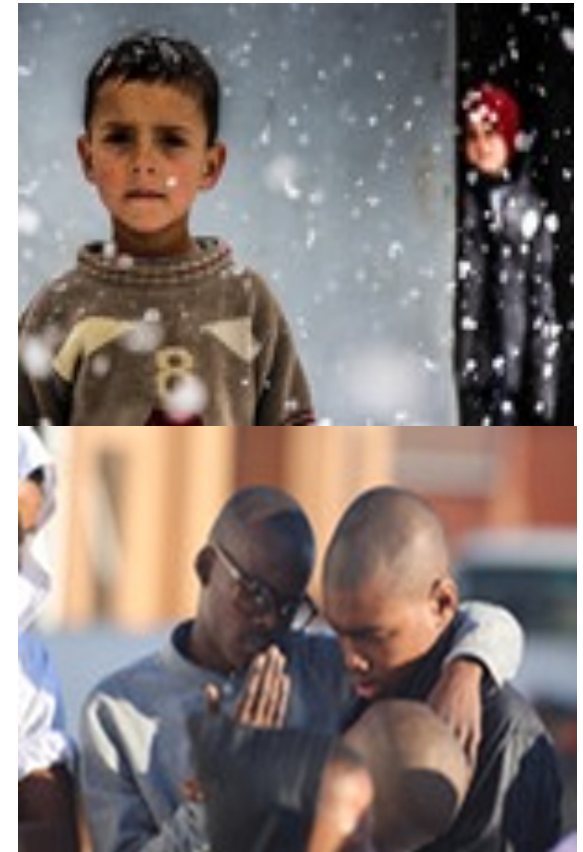

Child Protection Concerns

- Danger and injuries
- Physical violence
- Sexual violence
- Harmful practices
- Child labour
- Psychosocial distress and mental health concerns
- Child rights violations



What Basic Support Can Host Communities Provide



- Carry out a review of existing approaches to address the needs of children at risk
- More effective coordination of referral pathways which include local communities
- Psychosocial First Aid by faith actors
- Inclusive access to educational facilities - formal and informal
- Support activities for children in the communities



Promoting Wellbeing of Migrant and Refugee Children



- Promote key community health messaging through local faith communities
- Establish mechanisms for referrals to local faith actors for provision of psychosocial support and spiritual care
- Ensure faith sensitivity in mental Health service provision is available
- Work with faith actors offering non-formal education to build psychosocial support into their programme
